DEVELOPING YOUR PERSON VISION

1. Vision is Birthed out of a Concern
2. Vision is Developed Through Prayer

 - > Pray it Out | Goal: Lift of prayers, petitions, and praises

Start it Out | Goal: Get people talking

- Do you have a personal vision statement? Why or why not?
- Does knowing where you're going make a difference to how you get there? Explain.
- List the 4 "top priorities" for Disciples of Jesus listed in the Matthew 28:19-20. Discuss what it looks like to live out these priorities in your context.
- Respond to the following quote: You don't get to choose the game plan, but you do get to choose how you implement the game plan in your context.

Talk it Out | Goal: Get the group talking about scripture

- Review the main points from Nehemiah 1 & 2:
 - What was Nehemiah's greatest concern?
 - How did Nehemiah pray?
 - How long is to long to wait for a vision?
- During the waiting time, Nehemiah still put plans together, when developing a vision, what can you do ensure that "waiting time is not wasted time?"

Live it Out | Goal: Choose questions to encourage next steps

- Review the **DEVELOPING YOUR PERSON VISION** points. If you had to answer the question today, what would you say is your biggest concern? Has God been placing something on your heart that you now realize could be a vision?
- What is one thing you can do this week to make a difference in the world around you?

Pray it Out | Goal: Lift up prayers, petitions, and praises
